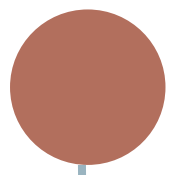

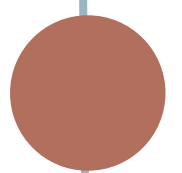

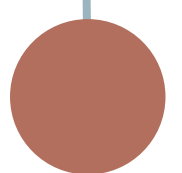
Progress Updates



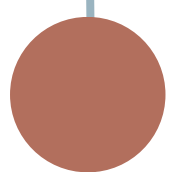

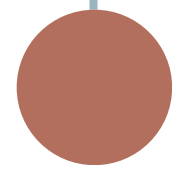
Commentary: **"Addressing Migrants in the National Adaptation Strategies: A Critical Assessment and Future Pathways"** submitted to *Lancet*.

Current Activities

"Facing Climate Change in Poverty" Research

We are currently in the recruitment phase and beginning our data analysis process to assess climate-related health risks for individuals living in poverty in Canada. This research involves conducting expert interviews, particularly with those who have lived experience. So far, we have conducted 33 interviews. In the coming year, we aim to engage more Francophone communities in this initiative.
